**Bible Round-up (All camps)**

Each day of camp features small group time focused on the Bible Round-up theme for the summer. For Summer 2010, our theme is "Light in the Darkness." We will discover how Jesus is the light in the darkness (John 8:12) and how we can share His light with those around us (Matthew 5:14-16). There will be a special focus on why following Jesus makes the most sense out of life in this world.

**Chuckwagon (All camps)**

**Free time activities (All camps)**

**Photo Package (All camps)**

**Cowboy Lunch (Round-Up #2, 3, 3D, and 4)**

During RU#2, 3, 3D, and 4, campers can choose to step into the boots of a cowboy and enjoy a COWBOY LUNCH cooked over a fire and served from WLD's authentic Chuckwagon. Complete this experience with a horse-drawn wagon ride. Space is limited, so be sure to reserve your spot early! (A \$15.00 fee for this activity is due at registration.)

**Activity Classes** – for Round-ups #2, 3, 3D, and 4 (Junior Camps, Teen Week, and Jr. High Day Camp)

*(Note: Specialty Camps and the Junior Day Camp have a separate list of specialty choices. See those descriptions for specialty choices. Pre-junior campers will sample many of these activities as part of their Pre-junior Camp experience.)*

Campers attending the Traditional Junior or Teen camps and the Jr. High Day Camp must choose an Activity Class for their week of camp. Activity Classes meet each morning except Friday. Choose an Activity Class from the list below. (Activity classes are limited in size and are on a first come, first serve basis. Please indicate a first and second choice when registering.)

**Adventure Team:** Learn to think creatively, to develop problem solving skills, to value teamwork, and to challenge yourself with a variety of adventure activities, including our challenge course, bouldering wall, canoeing, mountainboards, and more!

**Archery:** Learn about archery safety and work on developing precision and accuracy through target shooting and archery games. The class will use traditional recurve bows, but may have opportunities to shoot longbows and compound bows.

**Horsemanship:** Learn the basics of riding and caring for horses. Through our sequential riding program, campers build on their knowledge and skills from year to year. (There is an additional fee of \$20.00 due at registration for RU#2, 3, 3D, or 4.)

**Pioneer Crafts:** Have fun making items pioneers would have made as well as enjoying modern day crafts. You can take your projects home at the end of the week.

**Riflery:** Learn about firearm safety and shooting techniques of .22 caliber rifles. We will focus on the fundamentals of rifle shooting in order to improve accuracy for each camper. We will also continue to offer the NRA Marksmanship Qualification Program so that campers can progress in their Light Rifle qualification ratings.

**Elective Activities (Round-Up #2 and 4)**

During Round-ups #2 and 4 this summer, campers can choose an Evening Elective Activity to participate in. Activities may include Drama, Puppets, Challenge Course, Sports/Swimming, Fishing, Lassos and Trick Ropes, and more!
