Our staff facilitate recreational out-door activities, teambuilding challenges, opportunities for growth and development, relationship building, as well as horse riding for your enjoyment.

\*Packages are designed for weekends and include meals for Saturday and Sunday. Other retreat formats may be available by arrangement.

# WLD Retreats











WLD Ranch can accommodate 10 to 180 people. There are three sleeping facilities (heated and winterized). Meeting rooms are available for each. Typical combinations of sleeping facilities and meeting rooms are listed below, but this may vary depending on availability. All meals are served in the Longhorn Lodge. WLD Ranch provides all meals for groups using the facilities.

#### Longhorn Lodge and Buckskin Bunkhouse

For groups of 30-80 people (minimum charge for 30 people)

The Longhorn Lodge is centrally located on our

property. The Longhorn Lodge contains the Dining Room, Chapel, Double R Game Room, and Staff Offices. Our Dining Room feeds up to 180 people from a commercial kitchen. Near the Dining Room, there are two full bathrooms and our Nurse's Office. The Chapel meeting area holds up to 180 people (multimedia supplies are available). Its atmosphere is set off with a fireplace and rustic wooden beams. The Game Room provides a variety of games, including carpetball, foosball, and ping pong.

The Buckskin Bunkhouse is divided into four

sleeping areas, each sleeping 20 people (total capacity 80). Each sleeping area has its own bathroom, allowing the bunkhouse to be divided for men and women. The Latigo, a meeting room or gathering space, is conveniently adjacent to the sleeping areas of the Buckskin Bunkhouse (limited multimedia supplies are available). Paired with the Longhorn Lodge, this facility is ideal for groups of 30 to 80 people.



## Silver Star Station and Spur

For groups of 20 to 50 people (minimum charge for 20 people)

#### The Silver Star Station is divided into four

sleeping areas, each sleeping 18 people (total capacity 72). The Silver Star has two large bathrooms that divide the bunkhouse in half for men and women. The Spur, a meeting room or gathering space for up to 50 people, is conveniently adjacent to the sleeping areas of the Silver Star Station (limited multimedia supplies are available). The Silver Star and Spur are ideal for groups of 30 to 80 people.



#### Wrangler's Roost

For groups of 10 to 20 people (minimum charge for 10 people)



The Wrangler's Roost is a small sleeping facility for up to 20 people with two bathrooms (one on each floor). There are convenient entrances for the upstairs and the downstairs from the outside (to separate men and women). This sleeping facility may be paired with a meeting location in the Longhorn Lodge, depending on availability.

#### Buckskin, Silver Star, and Longhorn Lodge

Groups of 80 or more can use both bunkhouses and the Longhorn Lodge. (Minimum charge for 80)

## 2023 Overnight and Meal <u>Options</u>

The following costs are per person.

Option A: 2 overnights, 5 meals = \$89.00\*

Option B: 2 overnights, 4 meals = \$79.00\*

Option C: 1 overnight, 3 meals = \$59.00\*

Option D: 1 overnight, 2 meals = \$48.00\*

\*A pizza/chips/drink snack for Friday night can be added for \$5.00/person.







WLD Ranch's activities are available to groups who rent the facilities. All activities\* must be supervised/led by WLD staff. Weather may affect availability.

\*Hayrides: Tractor drawn wagon

(up to 25 people; 30 minutes) \$40.00 fee (additional wagon is \$25.00)

#### Horse-Drawn Wagon Ride

(up to 15 per wagon; 20 minutes) \$30.00 fee (Additional passengers are \$2.00 per person)

\*Horse Rides: Horse ride at a walk (8-10 people per ride; approx. 25 minutes, Includes instruction) \$5.00/rider

#### \*Challenge Course:

Groups less than 60: up to 2 hours (4-6 initiatives) = **no cost** (\$2/person each additional hour) Groups of 60+ = \$1/person/hour

#### \*Riflery: \$0.10 per shot
