Challenge Course


We offer over 30 different challenge course activities at WLD Ranch, allowing us to choose activities that will be appropriate for your group. Each activity

focuses on problem solving skills and working as a team to accomplish a goal. The majority of your field day's events will be challenge course activities. Activities may include swinging on the Nitro swing or Cargo Net, climbing across the Multi-vine or Burma Loops, traveling through the Group Cable Walk, and much more!




Archery

Your group may also choose to experience shooting with a bow and arrow during your field day. Each student will be given a chance to aim for the bulls-eye while trying a new skill.




Hayride
