

Summer Camp at WLD Ranch is an experience your campers won't soon forget. Our Round-ups are full of activities to make your camper's week full of memories.

Bible Round-Up (All camps) – GROW Fruit: Let God Change Your Life

Throughout the week, campers meet with camp counselors in cabin groups to focus on the Bible Round-Up theme for the summer. This summer, we'll look at Galatians 5:22-25 and challenge the campers to let God change their lives and produce His fruit in their lives. Galatians 5:22-23 says, "But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control." Campers will learn how God's Word, Relationships with God and with encouragers, Outreach to serve others, and Worshiping God can help them to "keep in step with the Spirit" as the Spirit of God produces His fruit in their lives.

Chuckwagon (All camps)

WLD's Chuckwagon is once again full of the latest Ranch wear and souvenirs and the greatest snacks around, so campers should come prepared! (We recommend depositing camper money into the WLD Ranch bank for safe keeping. Then they can access their account at the Chuckwagon.)

Free time activities (All camps)

Campers will have many supervised free time activities to choose from during the afternoons (and some evenings), including swimming, archery, riflery, horse rides/trail rides, bouldering wall, mountainboards, game room, and more!

Skill Tracks – for Round-ups #1, 1D, 2, 2D, 3, and 3D

(Note: Trailblazer and Explorer Round-ups have a separate list of skill track choices, described in full on the website. Tenderfoot campers will sample many of these tracks as part of their Tenderfoot Camp experience.)

Campers attending the Pathfinder Camps (overnight or day camps) must choose a Skill Track for their week of camp. Skill Tracks meet each morning except Friday. (Skill Tracks are limited in size and are first come, first served.)

Adventure Team: Learn to think creatively, to develop problem solving skills, to value teamwork, and to challenge yourself with a variety of adventure activities, including our challenge course, bouldering wall, canoeing, and more!

Archery: Learn about archery safety and work on developing precision and accuracy through target shooting and archery games. The class will use traditional recurve bows, but may have opportunities to shoot longbows and compound bows. They will also get to try their hand at tomahawks and atlatls.

Horsemanship: Learn the basics of riding and caring for horses. Through our sequential riding program, campers build on their knowledge and skills from year to year. (There is an additional fee of \$25.00 due at registration for RU#1, 1D, 2, 2D, 3 or 3D.)

Outdoor Skills: Learn valuable skills such as tying knots, building campfires safely, using a map and compass, and identifying animal tracks.

Pioneer Crafts: Have fun making items pioneers would have made as well as enjoying modern day crafts with a nature theme. You can take your projects home at the end of the week.

Riflery: Learn about firearm safety and shooting techniques of .22 caliber rifles. We will focus on the fundamentals of rifle shooting in order to improve accuracy for each camper.

For Round-ups #6 & 7D

Throughout the day, campers will enjoy a unique focus on Skill Tracks by choosing two of six Skill Tracks (one in the morning and one in the afternoon).

Morning Skill Tracks:

Horse Adventures: Spend time with the horses doing things not always part of the Pathfinder Roundup. Activities could include games on horseback, trailrides, cowboy skills like roping, and more.

Teambuilding Adventures: Participate with other campers to learn how to work well with one another with the use of our challenge course and other team-building activities.

Target Practice: Improve your aim with slingshots, tomahawks, atlatls, and archery with a tournament at the end of the week.

Afternoon Skill Tracks:

Hikes and Swikes: Learn about and enjoy nature while hiking around our property (primarily our woods) and swiking (*swim-hiking*) through and along our creek.

Pioneer Crafts: Have fun making items pioneers would have made as well as enjoying modern day crafts with a nature theme. You can take your projects home at the end of the week.

WLD Games: Enjoy disc golf, raptor, archery golf and other unique games we enjoy here at WLD Ranch.
